WHAT SHOULD MY CAMPER BRING TO CAMP?



- PLEASE PACK A LUNCH AND SNACKS IN A COOLER/LUNCHBOX SO IT WILL LAST THROUGH THE DAY.
- BRING A WATER BOTTLE **EVERYDAY!!** IT'S HOT AND WE'LL BE VERY ACTIVE. IT'S IMPORTANT TO STAY HYDRATED. THERE WILL BE PLACES TO REFILL WATER BOTTLES DURING THE DAY.
- SHOES ARE REQUIRED AT CAMP. BRING SANDALS OR CROCS FOR BEACH TIME AND CONSIDER WATER SHOES DURING SWIM TIME.
- CHILDREN SHOULD WEAR COMFORTABLE CLOTHING THAT REFLECTS THE WEATHER OF THAT DAY. PLEASE BRING A SWEATSHIRT OR LIGHT JACKET AS MAINE WEATHER IS KNOWN TO BE UNPREDICATABLE AT TIMES.
- BRING A BATHING SUIT AND TOWELS **EVERYDAY!!**
- BUG SPRAY AND SUN BLOCK SHOULD BE APPLIED PRIOR TO CAMP EVERYDAY. CAMPER SHOULD BRING THEIR OWN SUNBLOCK TO REAPPLY.

SIGN IN AND OUT PROCEDURE

- YOU MUST SIGN YOUR CHILD IN AND OUT EVERYDAY
- DEPENDING ON LOCATION THE STAFF MEMBER WITH THE CLIPBOARD IS WHO YOU WILL GO TO FOR SIGN-IN/OUT
- IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT WE KNOW WHEN YOUR CHILD COMES AND WHEN THEY LEAVE!!
- DROP OFF IS FROM 8:30 AND 9 A.M. MONDAY-FRIDAY AND PICK UP IS 3:30 P.M.
- DROP OFF AND PICK UP AT THE ICC IS NOW HAPPENING IN COMMUNITY PARK UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED
- A WEEKLY EMAIL WILL GO OUT ON SUNDAY FOR ANY DROP-OFF AND PICK UP LOCATION CHANGES, AND WEEKLY INFORMATION
- PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE **START** OF EACH WEEK!

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT



Campers are expected to behave appropriately and promote a safe, fun and healthy environment through productive participation. The staff will help the campers achieve this by using a positive approach to re-direction.

Participants who remain disruptive after consultation with the parents, may be dismissed from the program. Please review the Code of Conduct with your child so that he/she fully understands these expectations.

As an Adventure Camp camper, I agree to the following code of conduct:

Respect

- I will respect camp property, field trip sites, and all bus transportation. I will respect personal property of campers and staff and not take anything that doesn't belong to me. I will respect the camp staff and follow instructions. I will stay with my group and camp counselors. I will show respect to other participants and treat them with courtesy and consideration.

Behavior

- I will be a good camp friend and not fight or instigate a fight. I will not hurt anyone with unkind words or actions. I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting or fighting are not acceptable and will not be tolerated. I will refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm to other participants or staff.

I will conduct myself responsibly. I will refrain from taking part in or leading any bullying, harassment, name calling, unwanted teasing, gossiping, unkind behaviors, or exclusion of others from camp activities. I will refrain from discussing inappropriate subject matter.

Rules

- I know and will follow the rules of the camp. I will be responsible for my actions and understand that irresponsible behavior will result in disciplinary action, including potential dismissal from camp. I will always have the opportunity to meet with the Recreation Director or other camp staff to tell my side of any incident that is being reported to the camp office. I will have fun, learn, grow, make new friends and have a great time at camp.

Camper Behavior

- Camp is a place to have fun, improve skills, become more independent, make new friends, develop social skills, experience a different environment, and learn from positive adult role models. To be successful, all campers are expected to fully understand and act in accordance with our Behavior Management Policy. During registration a parent/ guardian will be required to sign an acknowledgement of this policy.

CAMP BEHAVIOR POLICY



Campers and staff will work together to develop agreements about what every camper and community member must do in order to uphold camp-wide expectations. We hope, through this process, that all learners in the camp community develop a robust understanding of the rules for participation.

Day-to-day, we expect the following from all participants:

- Share camp materials;
- Focus on camp activity with their best effort;
- Use kind words and friendly language
- Touch others only in gentle and appropriate ways. No "rough play" including tackle football, "play fighting", pushing, shoving, karate, etc;
- Follow instructions from camp staff at all times;
- Be where they have permission to be, leaving a space only with permission;
- Respect each other's privacy, space, and belongings;
- Take care of and keep in good condition the building and all property within.

Campers who are unable to meet camp-wide expectations will first be asked to take a break away from the rest of the campers and then reenter the activity when they are ready to repair the harm they have caused and/or fulfill any consequences established by camp staff.

Campers who frequently violate these expectations, or demonstrate violence (either in words or action) will result in the child being removed from the camp, either temporarily (as in a suspension) or permanently (as in expulsion). The Camp Director (in conjunction with the Recreation Director) maintains ultimate discretion in the enforcement of our discipline policy and encourages parents to reach out with any questions, comments, or concerns.

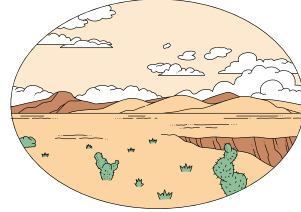

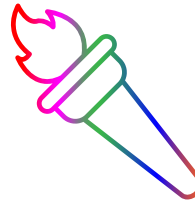

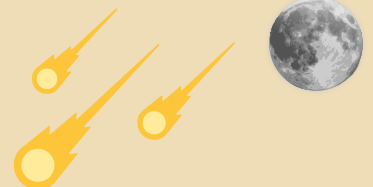
